



DIGITAL RETINAL IMAGING (DRI) PROCEDURE

As part of your comprehensive eye exam today Dr. Pinkham, O.D. will take a high-resolution retinal image of your eye with a computer-integrated system called Optomap.

This test is recommended for all our patients of all ages. It is especially important for those with a history of and/or a family history of:

- Diabetes
- High Blood Pressure
- Glaucoma
- Macular Degeneration
- Retinal diseases
- Flashing lights
- Decreased or distorted vision
- A strong glasses prescription



Even if you see well, many retinal conditions do not produce symptoms such as pain or blurred vision. Retinal photography helps in early detection of retinal problems to avoid vision loss/blindness and preserve superior eye health.

This permanent record is very valuable in assessing the current health of your eye and will also serve as a baseline for comparison at future visits. It is the gold standard for preventative care and disease management in preventing blindness.

The fee for this part of the eye exam is \$40.00. Typically, retinal images are not covered under most vision insurance plans.
